This learning resource contains a text about the weather during Christmas. You are going to answer a few questions to the text as well.

1. Read the text.

How is the weather during Christmas day? Well, that really depends. If you live in Sweden, you will probably see some snow when you wake up on December 24st. According to the website www.holiday-weather.com, the average temperature in December 2017 in Stockholm, Sweden is around -1°C . On the evenings and nights, the temperature drops a little more and it might be a little more windy. But it is totally different around the world. What if we took a look at Australia, for example? Using the same website, the average temperature in December 2017 in Sydney, Australia is 22°C , an average summer day in Sweden. So, the weather can be so different in many countries on just one single day.
